<p>3. <i>When I wanted to go to the cinema with him, he said "yes".</i></p>	<p>Als ich ihn fragte, ob er mit mir ins Kino gehen wolle, sagte er „ja“.</p>
<p>4. <i>At the cinema, someone said, "You must turn off your phone because the film is starting."</i></p>	<p>Im Kino sagte jemand: „ Du musst dein Telefon ausschalten, weil der Film (jetzt) beginnt.“</p>
<p>5. <i>When/After Tony heard that, he was shocked.</i></p>	<p>Als/Nachdem Tony das hörte, war er geschockt.</p>
<p>6. <i>Whenever/As soon as a phone rings at the cinema, it makes other people angry.</i></p>	<p>Wann immer/Sobald ein Telefon im Kino klingelt, macht es die Leute wütend.</p>
