- Evangelicals are Protestants who believe in the necessity of being born again.
- Call for a literal inerpretation of the Bible (i.e. God created the Earth in six days, on the seventh day He rested), or for *intelligent design*: "Godo r another active intelligence intervened at various points over the course of an otherwise uninterrupted natural evolutionary history to produce the complexity and diversity of life observed on Earth" (https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Evangelicalism in the United States#Evolution, 27.3.2020)
- the (political) left complains the evangelicals had too much influence → conservatives,
 political/religious right
- help certain politicians (conservative, right-wing) in elections
- GOP (Grand Old Party → Republicans) presidents (the two Bushs, Trump) appointed many conservative judges in the national (US Supreme Court) and federal judicial system; of course they are in favour of traditional Christian belief regarding abortion, same-sex marriage, education, and many other aspects)
 - (Check out Pink's song *Dear Mr. President* it is full of criticism on many aspects of daily life)
- Round about a quarter of the American population is of evangelical belief. In terms of social s status this proportian is too big to comprise only one single social group. Over 60% of all blacks, 44% of Hispanics and 38% of non-Hispanic whites sympathize with these traditional branches of religion (https://news.gallup.com/opinion/polling-matters/235208/things-know-evangelicals-america.aspx, 27.3.2020)
- Popular persons of political life: Ronald Reagan, Jimmy Carter, George W. Bush, Sarah Palin, Mike Pence
