Exercise 1:

- Lösungsvorschlag a) Typical aspects
 - · economic reasons causing immigration
 - · immigrants crossing the border illegally on foot
 - illegal immigration often makes several attempts necessary to get to the US
 - · immigrants often work as fruit pickers
 - they receive minimal wages
 - after many years now Armando has his papers and thus feels integrated into US society

b) Not very typical of an immigrant's story

- Armando married a US citizen
- Armando's parents-in-law are wealthy enough to be able to give him and their daughter a house.

Exercise 2:

Lösungsvorschlag Crossing the border

- Some immigrants are helped by family members, others have to hire a coyote.
- They are often caught and sent back.
- They often try to wait for a change of guards to cross the border.
- They must often hide so as not to be detected by "la migra".
- They are often dependent on Americans to help them with money and clothing.

Problems of (illegal) immigrants

- They often feel like a minority.
- They have no social security but pay taxes.

The political debate on immigration

- Illegal immigrants are welcomed because they pay taxes and social security without having the right to get any benefits in later years.
- If they were legalised, they would have to be refunded what they had earned.
- They are needed because they are willing to take jobs Americans don't want to do but face anti-American groups who want to seal up the border and make it impermeable.
